

Pull Up

The object of this game is to help the participants feel more at ease by playing a fun, fast-paced and competitive game large group game.

Set the room up with enough chairs in a circle for each participant. Have each participants sit in a chair. Take two males and two females and put them in the middle of the circle. Play some fast-paced contemporary Christian music. While the music is on, the participants in the middle will run across the circle pulling up participants in the circle of the opposite sex. by grabbing their hand. The person being pulled up cannot resist, but gets up and runs across the room (at least five chairs away) and pulls up another person of the opposite sex. Once you pull someone up, you then sit in their chair. Whoever is left in the middle when the music stops, is then counted. If there are four guys and zero girls, the girls would be awarded four points. If there are three girls and one guy, then the guys would be given two points. (Subtract the higher number with the lower number and give the difference to the gender with the lower number). Keep a running score. Choose a variety of different lengths of time to turn off the music. This will keep the participants hustling. To make things exciting, keep adding people to the middle as the game progresses. The more people running across the circle, the more fun the game gets.

The person who has this job is responsible for setting up. or organizing the setting up of the chairs, the explanation of the game, overseeing the game for a smooth operation, choosing and playing the music, and keeping score.
